Dear Families,

Now that the weather is looking a little more like winter, I want to share a few reminders with you.

- If you receive a robo call stating, “all after school activities have been canceled”, please note that all buildings will be closed. Every activity that was scheduled for that evening will either be rescheduled or canceled.
- If you are a parent that drives your child/ren to school, please make sure you are here before 8:30. The teachers are all required to be in their classrooms by 8:30. If you are late please continue to enter through the back entrance. You must stop at the side of the building, please do not pull up to the front of the school. All students must be signed-in by a parent/adult when they are late. Your child/ren are considered late at 8:30.
- Many of you have asked about volunteering your time. To do so, you will need to have a current BCI check on file with the school department. In order to volunteer for school store, field trips, etc... you will need an up to date BCI.
- Please don't forget to send a note in with your child if there will be a change in their dismissal routine. If we do not receive a note your child will automatically be dismissed as usual.
- As you know we have worked very hard to streamline our arrival and dismissal process. Unfortunately we still have parents/family members that want to pull to the front of the school. Our wonderful crossing guard Mr. Freddy has tried to keep our parking lot available for buses and teachers only. If you are asked to turn around to drop your child/ren off via the back entrance, please be respectful. Mr. Freddy is doing his job by asking you to turn around and join the line for drop off, please don't ignore what he is saying.
- Speeding down East Shore Drive to get in line for drop off is still a problem. Please note; we have families that are crossing this road and driving fast is putting these families at risk of getting hit. PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY.
