Drop Off and Dismissal

Our new school hours will be 8:15am-3:00pm. Drop off for cars and buses can begin at 8:10am. School will start promptly at 8:30. All students that enter the building after 8:30 will be considered late. Student pick-up will begin at 2:55pm. Our arrival and dismissal procedures have remained the same for the 2023-2024 school year. Parents that drive their child/ren to and from school will continue to do so in the back of the building. No cars will be allowed in the front of the building; this area will be reserved for buses only. All students that ride a bus and children from the neighborhood that do not qualify for bussing (walkers) will be dropped off and dismissed in the front of the building. A list will be generated of the neighborhood families. Please do not park your car in the neighborhood and walk up to the school. If your child qualifies for busing, we highly recommend that you utilize the bus service.

Electronic Devices

Cell phones and electronic devices are not allowed during school time. If a student brings a device to school, it must remain in their backpack or coat pocket and all risks associated with this technology being at school become the owner's responsibility. Parents will be contacted if a student fails to keep the electronics in the proper place.

If you have information that you as a parent feel is important for the school to know in these placement decisions, it is important to meet with the school principal and put your information in writing prior to June for next year's considerations.
